Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to
remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of
non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will
place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case



registered for the offence punishable under Sections 302, 120(B), and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act pending in the Court of learned Court below.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that there is general and omnibus allegation levelled against the petitioners and there is no material in the case diary against the petitioners. He submits that there is no eye witness in this case. He further submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Per contra, learned APP for the State vehemently opposing the bail petition submitted that the police has completed the process under Section 82 & 83 Cr.P.C. in the present case, hence they do not deserve anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail in connection with Lakhisarai P.S. Case No.03/2022. Accordingly, their prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby rejected.
