2 14-10-2022 The limited prayer of the petitioner in the present writ petition is to direct the Circle Officer, Madhepura i.e. the respondent no. 4 to demarcate the land of the petitioner, description whereof, is as follows :-

Ansh New Area 8.096 decimal, Khata no. 3*

New Area 4.359 Decimal and Khata 3 Old
316 New, Khesra 518 Old, 678 Ansh new,
Ara 13.009 Decimals, all situated at Mauza-
Bhirkhi Uttarwari, Ward no. 20, Nagar
Parishad, Madhepura, PS-Madhepura,
District-Madhepura.”*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 4 with regard to his aforesaid grievance. Liberty so sought, is granted.

It is needless to state that in case, the petitioner approaches the respondent no. 4 by filing appropriate representation, within a period of four weeks from today, the respondent no. 4 shall consider his application and after hearing the affected parties as also the private respondents no. 7 to 11, shall pass appropriate order thereon, in accordance with law, within a period of 12 weeks, thereafter.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
