Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



1. That the petitioner prays for issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions for quashing the communication dated 04.06.2021 by which the candidature of the petitioner as selected candidate has been rejected on the ground of document submitted regarding the land offered not valid and therefore candidature has been found ineligible. However the land offered by the petitioner is valid as per the brochure for selection of dealership clause VI sub clause C, the petitioner is owner of the land and no objection certificate has been also given regarding the said land by the co-sharers.

The petitioner further made alternative prayer for consider the reply dated 08.06.2021 of rejection dated 04.06.2021 by which the petitioner has seek indulgence to grant time for submission of registered sale deed document regarding land.

The petitioner further prays for dispose off the present case in the light of order dated 06.08.2018 passed in C.W.J.C. no. 14425/2018.

And for the any other relief the petitioner may be found entitled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a fresh petition, on the same and subsequent cause of action, in accordance with law, if so required and desired.

Permission granted with liberty, as prayed for.

Liberty also reserved to the petitioner to make a mention for listing of the petition on priority basis.



As and when any such mention is made, Registry shall take steps for listing the petition at the earliest.

Instant petition stands disposed of as withdrawn in the aforesaid terms.
