2 31-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, as pointed out by the office
be removed within four weeks.

The petitioner is in judicial custody in connection
with POCSO Case No. 127 of 2021 arising out of Mahila
(Sadar) P.S. Case No. 17 of 2015 for the offences under Sections
376D of the Indian Penal Code and Section 6 of the POCSO
Act.

The matter relates to 2015 and as per the FIR it relates
to Section 376D of the Indian Penal Code and Section 6 of the
POCSO Act.

In this case, the bail was granted to the petitioner who



misused the same and remained an absconder for five (5) long years before surrendering on 03.02.2022 with the sole purpose of delaying the trial which can be seen that the moment he surrendered, the charges were framed on 04.03.2022.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant him the privilege of bail and he must co-operate in the trial and see to it that the same is concluded without any further delay.

The bail application is accordingly rejected.
