ORAL ORDER

7 21-07-2022 In compliance of the earlier order of this Court dated 30.06.2022, 90 per cent pension of the petitioner for the period 01.01.2020 to 16.07.2021 has stood paid, however it is the contention of the petitioner that now since the order of punishment dated 16.07.2021 has been passed, whereby and whereunder 100 per cent pension, 100 per cent gratuity and leave encashment amount of the petitioner has been forfeited, the petitioner be granted liberty to seek redressal of his subsisting grievances, in accordance with law.



Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed, however, with liberty to the petitioner to seek redressal of his subsisting grievances, in accordance with law.
