ORAL ORDER

2 05-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under sections 30(a), 36 and 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016 and sections 272, 273 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, 99 litres of liquor was recovered from the Scorpio vehicle in which the petitioner was one of the occupants. Besides, 180 litres of liquor was recovered from a tempo and 792 litres of liquor was recovered from a house.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. No incriminating article has been recovered from his possession.



He is in custody since 8.5.2021 and has no criminal antecedent.

Chargesheet has been submitted in the case.

Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case especially the petitioner not having any criminal antecedent and chargesheet having been submitted in the case, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Malaypur P.S. Case no. 66 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Jamui.
