2 08-09-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in a case registered under sections 25(1-B)(a), 26
and 35 of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, on seeing the police, the
petitioner and his father started fleeing away but were
apprehended by the police and on search, one loaded country-
made pistol was recovered from the possession of the petitioner
and a cartridge was recovered from the possession of the



petitioner's father.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The father of the petitioner is an advocate as well as a social worker. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 05.03.2022.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned concerned Court below, Jamui in connection with Jhajha P.S. Case No. 77 of 2022.

The application stands allowed.
