Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Sikandra P.S. Case No. 152 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 504, 337 and 338 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the nature of injuries sustained by the accused persons which includes the petitioners, this anticipatory bail application is allowed.



Accordingly, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jamui, in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case No. 152 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
