A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 467, 468, 471 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 30(a), 38 and 41(i) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 2787.765 liter of liquor from two cars, one scooty and one container.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession, it is next submitted that none of the vehicles belong to the petitioner nor



the petitioner is driver of any of the vehicles and petitioner came to be implicated at the instance of local *chowkidar*, it is next submitted that it appears that *chowkidar*, with a view to save the real culprits, falsely implicated the petitioner who is a person with clean antecedent

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 451 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
