2 29-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of dowry death.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners and no specific overt act has been alleged against them who happen to be bhaisur, gotini and cousin mother-in-



law of the deceased. They are separate in mess and business and have no concern with the affairs of the deceased and her husband. Thrust of allegation is against the husband of the deceased, who has already been enlarged on regular bail by a bench of this Court vide order passed in Cr.Misc.No. 26851 of 2020. .

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioners, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate III, Madhubani in Khajauli Police Station Case No. 86 of 2018, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
