3 01-09-2022 On the last occasion on 21.07.2022, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner to press this application.

By filing the present application, the petitioner seeks quashing of the F.I.R. bearing Sahar P.S. Case No. 87 of 2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468/34 of the Indian Penal Code against the petitioner.

Prima facie, from the F.I.R. it appears that the allegation levelled in the F.I.R. constitutes offences as alleged in the F.I.R., however for the last two occasions no one is appearing on behalf of the petitioner to press the application,
