2 06-12-2022 Though the present writ petition was filed for considering the case of promotion of the petitioner to Class-III post, however, the learned counsel for the respondent State has filed a counter affidavit, wherein, in paragraphs no. 4 and 5, it has been stated that the petitioner was initially appointed against Class- IV posts as Treasury Guard on compassionate ground vide Office Order dated 17.10.1992 and at that point of time, the educational qualification of the petitioner was intermediate, however, such employees, who are appointed on compassionate



ground are not entitled to be given any promotion, as is apparent from the resolution of the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, Bihar dated 05.10.1991, especially Clause-9 (Ka) thereof.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this Court finds that the present writ petition is devoid of any merit, hence, is dismissed.
