2 14-11-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“i. To set aside the tender notice dated 25.1.2019 issued under the signature of District Magistrate and District Programme Officer, Darbhanga published in the daily news paper Prabhat Khabar on 13.2.2019 for selection of contractor for supply of mid-day



meal under the Bihar State Mid-Day Meal Scheme of the Education Department as there are various defects and irregularities in the tender notice.

ii. To direct the respondents to publish a fresh tender after rectifying the defect and accept the candidature of the petitioners for participation in the tender process after setting aside the work order issued in favour of respondent no.5 and 6 for supply of the Mid_Day Meal in Gaura Bauram and Darbhanga Sadar block within the district of Darbhanga.

iii. To grant any other relief or reliefs for which petitioners are legally entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Prayer allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
