2 02-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a),
41(i) and 32 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

It is a case of recovery of liquor from the bamboo
orchard.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He
further submits that he has no concern with the seized liquor
and nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession
of the petitioner and he has not been apprehended at the spot.
Petitioner has clean antecedent.



Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No.2, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Excise Case No. 207 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
