ORAL ORDER

2 18-10-2022 At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to make some necessary correction in para 1 of the petition.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Koilwar P.S. Case no. 436 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 342, 323, 447, 34 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assaulting and setting fire by the petitioner due to which informant sustained burnt injury.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners



has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. They have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that good sense has been prevailed between the parties. Petitioner no.1 is mother and petitioner no.2 is wife of the younger brother of the informant. They have got no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Koilwar P.S. Case no. 436 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Bhojpur, Ara subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
