2 20-09-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in a case registered under section 394 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, two unknown miscreants
boarded on a motorcycle intercepted the informant's son who
was returning on a pickup van after delivering goods from
Bhagalpur. They snatched Rs. 1, 40,000/- and a mobile phone
from the informant's son and also fired on him causing injuries.



Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused Md. Nisar but the confessional statement has no value in the eyes of law. The petitioner is accused in one more criminal case as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 17.10.2021.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of detention, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Bhagalpur in connection with Nathnagar (Madhusudanpur) P.S. Case No. 516 of 2021.

The application stands allowed.
