2 29-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under sections 25(1-B)a, 26 and 35 of
the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. He submits that the petitioner has been made accused in
this case because he is owner of the vehicle from which
recovery of arms and ammunition has been made. He submits
that in fact at the relevant time two co-accused, namely, Amit
Kumar and Ashraful Seikh have been apprehended with the
vehicle. No incriminating material has been recovered from the
conscious possession of the petitioner and he is no way
connected with the aforesaid recovery. Petitioner has got no



criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner mentioned above be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate IV, Banka in Shambhuganj Police Station Case No. 23 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
