2 07-03-2022 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present application has become infructuous as against the petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 5 who have been arrested and seeks permission to withdraw the same.

It is, thus, dismissed as withdrawn as having become infructuous as against the petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.



The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Chakai P.S. Case No. 12/2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

There are general and omnibus allegations against the petitioner No. 2 who is brother-in-law of the deceased whereas petitioners No. 3 and petitioner No. 4 are the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased and they are 75 years and 69 years of age.

Considering the facts and circumstances and taking into consideration the age of petitioners No. 3 and 4, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the **petitioners No. 2, 3 and 4** above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 5th, Jamui, in connection with Chakai P.S. Case No. 12/2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
