ORAL ORDER

2 16-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State through video conference. Learned counsel for the petitioners has filed an undertaking that all defects pointed out by the stamp reporter shall be removed, and compliance with the conditions of the notices of this Court with regard to acceptance of e-filing shall be made, without delay immediately upon resumption of normal physical functioning of the Court, and in any event within one month thereof.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners Mr. Raghav Prasad submits that this anticipatory bail application has become infructuous and as such the same need not be pressed.

3. The anticipatory bail application accordingly stands



dismissed, as having become infructuous.
