ORAL ORDER

2 09-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 307 and 498(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Act.

Allegedly, it is a case of cruelty to the informant due to non-fulfilment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners



that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioners are in-laws of the informant and they have no concern with the mess and business of the informant and her husband. Petitioners have clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioners, above named in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Siwan in connection with Siwan Mahila P.S. Case No. 51 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
