Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Shankarpur P.S. Case No. 47 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Considering the fact that the occurrence has taken place on account of land dispute and the petitioners have clean antecedent, this anticipatory bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-I, Madhepura, in connection with Shankarpur P.S. Case No. 47 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
