3 21-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 376, 341, 323, 504, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of POCSO Act.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that specific accusation of misconduct is against co-accused Ganesh Yadav. Petitioners have been made accused in this case merely because they are mother and sister-in-law of co-accused Ganesh Yadav. Petitioners have got clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the fact that petitioners are lady, having



clean antecedent, and specific accusation is against co-accused Ganesh Yadav, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge- VI cum Special Judge (POCSO), Supaul in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 77 of 2021, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
