2 29-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, counsel for informant and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of dowry death.

It is submitted that petitioner no. 1 is father-in-law and petitioner no. 2 is mother-in-law of the deceased. There is general and omnibus allegation. Thrust of accusation is against husband of the deceased who is already in custody. Petitioners are in-laws and they are separate in mess and property and have got no concern with the family affairs of the deceased and her



husband. Petitioners claim clean antecedents.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioners above-named, in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Khagaria in connection with Parbatta (Maraiya) P.S. Case No. 467 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
