2 25-03-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner, after some argument, seeks permission to withdraw this application with a liberty to prefer appeal against the impugned order dated 16.06.2021, passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer-cum-Licensing Authority, Danapur, whereby the petitioner's licence to run a PDS Shop under Bihar Targeted Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2016, has been cancelled.

This application is permitted to be withdrawn with the liberty as sought. If any appeal is preferred within four weeks



from today with an application seeking condonation of delay in preferring the appeal, the same shall be decided by the Appellate Authority on merits after condoning the delay, keeping in mind the fact that the petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this Court by filing present writ application. The Appellate Authority must dispose of the petitioner's appeal within the time frame prescribed under the Control Order, 2016.
