2 16-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) of
the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016

It is a case of recovery of English liquor from the
house of co-accused.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He
further submits that no incriminating wine was recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner and petitioner has not
been apprehended at the spot.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the
anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 4th Additional District & Sessions Judge, Excise-II, Nalanda in connection with Parwalpur P.S. Case No. 52 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
