APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

It is a case of recovery of liquor from a vehicle.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that no incriminating wine was recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and he has no concern with the seized vehicle and petitioner has not been apprehended at the spot. Petitioner has clean antecedent.



Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Exclusive Special Excise Court-I, Sitamarhi in connection with Sonbarsa P.S. Case No. 243 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
