Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



(i) For issuance of An appropriate writ in the nature of certiorary for quashing the rejection letter of candidature of the petitioner, issued vide letter no. REF No. MDO/KSK/616 dated 22.8.2020 by respondent No.3, in which he mentioned that minimum eligible funds i.e. Rs. 12 lacs not found available as on date of affidavit as per Appendix XA. So far it relates to an application for award of K.S.K. dealership of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. of Retail outlet Dealership (Petroleum Articles) to open the same at the location within 1 km.

from(Jamunaha -1 km) store towards Bathua Bazar, Dist.- Gopalganj under OBC category and an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamous directing the respondents to accept the application of petitioner for above mentioned location.

(ii) For issuance of Any other writ/writs, order/orders or direction/directions as the facts and circumstances of the case may require and deemed fit and proper by this Hon'ble Court may also be issued.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Bench not to be in favour of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petition, in its



present form, may be permitted to be withdrawn reserving liberty to file afresh with better particulars on the same and subsequent cause of action, if so required and desired.

Prayer allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

As and when such petition is filed, registry shall process it immediately and have it listed before the appropriate Court.

Also liberty reserved to the petitioner to take recourse to such other remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.

Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
