This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Motipur P.S. Case No. 184 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Finding no evidence against the petitioner, the Police exonerated him and submitted final form but the Court below differing with the same, has taken cognizance against the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within ten weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M. 2nd (West) Muzaffarpur, in connection with Motipur P.S. Case No. 184 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
