2 18-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under sections 30(a) and 38(I) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 237.25 litres of liquor was recovered from the vehicle being driven by the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated in the case. No incriminating article has been recovered from his vehicle. He is in custody since 23.3.2021 and has no criminal antecedent. Chargesheet has been submitted in the case.

Heard learned APP for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case, the petitioner having remained in custody for over 9 months and not having any criminal antecedent, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Kahalgaon P.S. Case no. 200 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge II – cum – Special Judge, Excise Act, Bhagalpur.
