ORAL ORDER

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Principal Secretary, Department of Food and Consumer Protection, Government of Bihar, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances.

Liberty so sought is granted.



It is needless to state that in case appropriate representation is filed by petitioner before the respondent no.2, with regard to his aforesaid grievances, within a period of four weeks from today, the respondent no.2, shall pass appropriate orders thereon, in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks, thereafter.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
