2 29-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 147, 148, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506 of the



Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assaulting due to which the informant and other family members sustained injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the petition with respect to petitioner Nos. 5 and 7 namely Prabhu Yadav and Rahul Yadav since they have been arrested.

Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the petition with respect to petitioner Nos. 5 and 7 is permitted to be withdrawn.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that in the background of some land dispute, the present F.I.R has been registered. There is counter version of the occurrence also and petitioners' side also received injuries. There is no accusation of repeating the blow. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, except petitioner Nos. 5



and 7, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st, Class, Saran at Chapra in connection with Daudpur P.S. Case No. 356 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
