Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That this is an application for issuance a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other writ or writs, direction or direction commanding the respondents particularly the respondent no.5 (the Branch Manager, United India Insurance Company Ltd. Biharsharif, Nalanda) to ensure the payment of insured value of Rs. 4,94,350/- to the petitioner of vehicle registration no. BR- 53- A- 8442, Engine no. GHF1G42002, Chassis no. MA12N2GHKF1G59431, modal Mahindra Bolero Pickup van CBC 2WD, whereby and where under the said vehicle of the petitioner has been stolen within insured period in this regard FIR has been lodged as Khusrupur PS case no. 124 / 17 on 1.07.2017 against unknown.



After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not in favour of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner shall be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and to take recourse to such other alternate remedies which are equally efficacious in law.

Prayer allowed.

The petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
