2 22-03-2022 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition of petitioner no.3, namely, Shiv Narayan Yadav.

Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the petition of petitioner no.3, namely,



Shiv Narayan Yadav is dismissed as withdrawn.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 447, 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assault upon the informant by the accused persons.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioners were not apprehended at the spot and no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners. Petitioners have clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, namely, Shailendra Yadav, Umesh Yadav, Vikash Yadav, Mukesh Yadav, Bhajan Yadav, Babloo Yadav, Pankaj Yadav and Shankar Yadav, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of



the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-II,
Madhepura in connection with Murliganj P.S. Case No. 118 of
2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section
438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
