2 22-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, Opposite
Party No.2 and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323,
498(A), 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of dowry demand against the petitioner.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further
submits that petitioner is father-in-law of the Opposite Party
No.2. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

However, learned APP for the State opposes the
prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.



Considering the present stand of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri K.P. Arya, Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Barh, District-Patna in connection with Complaint Case No. 497 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
