ORAL ORDER

2 16-11-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in a case registered under section 392 of the
Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, the informant Sonu
Sharma was going to his *sasural* and three miscreants
obstructed him by giving him a *danda* blow on his head and
looted his motorcycle and his bag carrying purse, mobile
phone, ATM cards, clothes and cash of Rs. 1,500/- on the gun



point.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused Md. Siddiki. The petitioner is accused in two other criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 28.02.2020.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of detention, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Banka in connection with Amarapur P.S. Case No. 541 of 2019.

The application stands allowed.
