ORAL ORDER

4 18-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Palasi P.S. Case No. 255 of 2020 registered under Section
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. There is general and omnibus allegation against
the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State
opposed the prayer of the petitioner by contending that
petitioner is owner of the recovered vehicle from which the
alleged recovery has been made. Hence, the petitioner does not
deserve to be enlarged on anticipatory bail.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the submission advanced on behalf of the State, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer of the petitioner is rejected.
