Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- (1) For issuance of an appropriate writ/s, direction/s, order/s in the nature of mandamus for commanding the respondent/s to restore the electrical connection of the petitioner premises, immediately.



- (ii) For issuance of appropriate writ/s, direction/s, order/s in the nature of certiorari for quashing of a First Information Report, bearing Dighwara P.S. Case No. , 262 of 2019 registered on dated 29.08.2019 under sections 134 of the Electricity Act, as well as demand bill dated 28.03.2014.
- (iii) Any other relief/s for which the petitioner may found entitled.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, before the appropriate forum, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law.

Needless to add, period for which the petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court, shall be excluded for the purpose of computing limitation.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues are left open.

the liberty aforesaid.
