2 22-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Birpur P.S. Case no. 323 of 2021 instituted for the offence
under Sections 341, 323, 354, 354B, 354D, 353, 504, 509, 34
of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, when the informant was
returning after pacifying the quarrel of Puja Pandal, the
petitioner along with other co-accused persons started outrage
the modesty and threatening her with bad intention.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no
offence. He has falsely been implicated in this present case. It is



further submitted that when the informant made complaint of outrage the modesty against the petitioner thereafter, he abused to her. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of outrage the modesty against the petitioner.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Birpur P.S. Case no. 323 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Birpur (Supaul) subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
