ORAL ORDER

(Per: HONOURABLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE)

11 01-08-2022 Petitioner has prayed for following reliefs:-

(i) To issue an appropriate writ/ order/ direction Indian nature of certiorary, quashing the ordinance for the admission of 2 year B.Ed course(as far as admission and fixation of fee is concerned) which has been accorded assent by the Honorable chancellor of universities in purported exercise of power vested in him under section 38 (4) and 39(2) (ii) of the Bihar State University act 1976 and Patna University act 1976 with the condition that the fee for the B.Ed would be fixed for rupees 95000/-provisionally issued vide letter no BSU(Regulation)-16/2015-1283/GS/I dated 02.09.2015 by the officer on special duty (judicial), Governor Secretariat, Bihar, Raj.

(ii) To issue an appropriate writ / order / direction, to allow the petitioners institution to conduct B ED entrance test and to take admission on the basis of the merit obtained in B ED entrance test and also to allow to devise its own fee structure.

(iii) To issue an appropriate writ / order / direction, in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent University to issue registration forms to the students already admitted in the respective petitioners

Institution on the basis of entrance test conducted by the petitioner's institution.

(iv) For Any other relief or reliefs for which the petitioners are entitled to.

On 16.04.2018, the Court had passed the following order:-

“None is present on behalf of the petitioner.

As none is present for the petitioner, list after four weeks.”

On 20.06.2018, the Court had passed the following order:-

“No one appears for the petitioner.

List after six weeks.”

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the matter was called out even last week, when none appeared for the petitioner.

Even today, despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

As such, the present petition stands dismissed for default.
