ORAL ORDER

13 17-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 453C of 2018 registered under Section
498A and 494 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further by filing supplementary
affidavit, he submits that petitioner is ready to pay Rs. 2,000/-
every month to his wife till disposal of the divorce case.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the

event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M., Supaul in connection with Complaint Case No. 453C of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
