4 28-04-2022 The application of petitioner no.1 has already been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 09.09.2021.

Heard both sides.

Petitioner nos.2 and 3 apprehend their arrest in Mahila P.S. Case No.36 of 2021 registered under Sections 376, 420 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that there is specific allegation against co-accused Manohar Kumar Singh. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing personal bonds to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Saran at Chapra in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.36 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
