ORAL ORDER

3 27-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No.1612/2014 (Tr. No.412/15), registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 448,
380, 427, 504 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that on the order of co-accused, Binod
Ram, the petitioners demolished the newly constructed house,
old house, boundary, lavatory etc. with J.C.B. Machine and
other accused persons looted the entire household articles.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the



present case. It is submitted that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail application. It is further submitted that petitioner no.1 is driver and petitioner no.2 is owner of J.C.B. It is submitted that out of 14 persons named in the present case, 12 persons have been granted anticipatory bail by the learned court below itself.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Taking into consideration the facts aforesaid, let petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing the bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Chapra in connection with Complaint Case No.1612/2014 (Tr. No.412/15), subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
