3 06-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Let the defect(s) be removed within two weeks of the
complete start of the physical Court in normal course.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 647 of 2020, registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 20, 22, 23, 24, 27, 27(A) and
29 of N.D.P.S. Act, pending in the Court of learned Sessions
Judge-1st-cum-Special Judge, NDPS, Vaishali, Hajipur.

The allegation is of recovery of half kilogram of
Charas from the possession of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been
implicated in this case. The alleged recovery of Charas is more
than small quantity and less than commercial quantity. The



petitioner is in custody since 02.10.2020.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and taking into consideration the quantity of narcotics i.e. Charas recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail, at this stage. Accordingly, the prayer for grant of regular bail is rejected.

The Superintendent of Police, Vaishali at Hajipur is directed ensure the presence of all the prosecution witnesses before the trial Court on the date fixed without fail.

However, the learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, well within a period of nine months. If no substantial progress takes place in trial, the petitioner, if so advised, may renew his prayer for bail after nine months.
