APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Gaunaha P.S. Case No.41 of 2020 registered for offences under Sections 363 and 366A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the POCSO Act.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that after investigation, the petitioner has been exonerated by the police but differing with the final form, learned Magistrate has taken cognizance.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Accordingly, let petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge 7th-cum-Special Judge POCSO, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Gaunaha P.S. Case No.41 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
