A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Akbarpur P.S. Case No. 753 of 2020 registered under Section 30 (a)(c) of the Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case due to village politics. Further submission is that on perusal of seizure list, it would be evident that petitioners have no concern with the place of occurrence, or poultry farm and the alleged motorcycle.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the

case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional District and Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Nawada in connection with Akbarpur P.S. Case No. 753 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
