learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks

permission to withdraw the petition with respect to

petitioner No. 1 namely Murari Yadav @ Mukhi Yadav

since he has been arrested.

Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the petition with respect to

petitioner No. 1 is dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioner No. 2 is apprehending his arrest



in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 427, 448, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assaulting due to which the informant and his father sustained injuries. The accused persons also damaged the motorcycle of the informant and took away Rs. 15,000/- and gold chain worth Rs. 50,000/-.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner No. 2 that in the background of some previous dispute, the present F.I.R has been registered. Moreover, good sense has prevailed between the parties and a compromise petition has been filed before learned Court below which has been annexed as Annexure-3 to the petition. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner No. 2 has no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner No. 2, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a



period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 333 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
