A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 56(c) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was apprehended from the spot but later he was released by the police as it has been specifically pleaded at paragraph '19' of the anticipatory bail application, it is next submitted that police realizing it's difficulty did not keep the petitioner in custody.

In the event, if the petitioner surrenders on or before 31.08.2022, the learned trial court shall dispose of the case on the same day keeping in mind that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and admittedly no recovery was made from his conscious possession.
