- (I) For issuance of a writ/writs in the nature of certiorari for set aside of Inspection Report dated 17.6.15 inspected by the Respondent no.3 and 4 in the premises of S.V.J. Enterprises, Pvt. Limited, Director, Veena Jha, Industrial Area, Donar, Darbhanga, whereby and whereunder excess bill amount, has been charged to S.V.J. Enterprises, Darbhanga.
- (II) For issuance of a writ/writs in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents as to why excess Electricity Bill charge has been submitted to the petitioner.
- (III) For commanding the respondents as to why in Inspection Report dated 17.06.2015 electricity bill of those machineries (Points) has been charged which are not in function.
