2 18-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 510 liters of liquor from bags from a field situated behind the poultry farm of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession, it is next submitted that even the recovery is from a place which is situated behind the poultry farm of the petitioner as such based



on suspicion, petitioner came to be implicated as the alleged place of recovery is near his poultry farm. Learned counsel submits that petitioner was implicated based on secret information which is the easiest way to implicate a person to save the real culprits.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Sahiyara P.S. Case No. 10 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
