Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Chakai P.S. Case No. 47 of 2021 registered for offences
under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of the
Essential Commodities Act.

Considered the submissions of the parties.

Petitioner will deposit Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty
thousand) in the District Legal Aid Committee, Jamui.

Accordingly, let petitioner, above-named, in the event
of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Chakai P.S. Case No.47 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that if the petitioner produces a receipt showing deposit of Rs.50,000/- in the District Legal Aid Committee, Jamui, his bail bond shall be accepted by the court below. In case the petitioner does not produce the aforesaid receipt, his bail bond shall automatically stand cancelled and he will be taken into custody forthwith.

With the aforesaid observation and direction, this application is allowed.
